¹ Defendants note for the Court that this stipulation triggers the protective order’s 60-day timeline in which the parties must destroy all documents that were designated as “confidential.” See Doc. 137 ¶ 16. Defendants are currently in meet-and-confer discussions with WPATH regarding a small portion of documents that WPATH produced that Defendants believe were improperly designated as “confidential.” Defendants hope to resolve the issue without the Court’s involvement but flag the issue because they may need to seek expedited relief under the protective order to minimize the risk of prejudice caused by the possibility of a fifth lawsuit challenging Alabama’s law.
